- Does not do content inspection, raises question of discrimination between legal and illegal
- Large price tag has most colleges reluctant
- Low level of recidivism also makes investment questionable
- History lesson on Edison and the entertainment industry

 - Already had issues with incompatible formats

 - In many other ways Edison was disconnected from what made success in the new market
 - Already see that hit making ruled the market
 - Much of what Edison did pre-figures the issues are struggle with today
