	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listening to TWiL <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Talking about Avvo • Denise mentioned some frustration with managing profile data • I enjoy social networks <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I have many far flung friends • IM, phone, even email are too disruptive, demanding • Blogs are useful, but not necessarily personal • Social networks, applications add a personal, low demand aspect • Complements other tools • After the second network, though, get tired of adding <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Profile data is essentially the same • ID manager isn't complete enough for whole profile • Profile and identity aren't the same, anyway • Consistency is a recurring costs • Must change all networks • ID manager cannot address friends • Re-adding all the same friends is a drag • How about a profile, friend protocol <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can use many blog servers as Open ID identifiers • Expand this to provide structured profile data • Social networks can query and refresh as needed • Already structure for friends, XFN • Same idea, social network app crawls XFN at "home site" • Would need to augment to indicate reciprocity, maybe • Could probably be done by simple link traversal • Before I sign up for any more social networks, I want to see at least one that re-uses existing data • I will build an open profile and XFN data if I never have to do so again • The value of the network is not the profile, friends <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This is the minimum structure need to hang exchanges
