Key 1: Pause patiently

- Silence may lead to a sanctified life

When there are many words, sin is unavoidable, but the one who controls his lips is wise.

(Proverbs 10: 19 HCSB)

Key 1: Pause patiently

- Silence may lead to a secure life

*The one who guards his mouth protects his life; the one who opens his lips invites his own ruin.
(Proverbs 13: 3 HCSB)*

Key1: Pause patiently

- Silence may lead to a secure life

The one who guards his mouth and tongue keeps himself out of trouble. (Proverbs 21: 23 HCSB)

Key 2: Listen lovingly

- When we listen we receive counsel before making choices

A fool's way is right in his own eyes but whoever listens to counsel is wise. (Proverbs 12: 15 HCSB)

Key 2: Listen lovingly

- When we listen we receive correction after making mistakes

An ear that listens to life-giving rebukes will be at home among the wise. (Proverbs 15: 31 HCSB)

Key 2: Listen lovingly

- When we listen we receive confidence when making statements

...the one who listens will speak successfully. (Proverbs 21: 28b)

Key 3: Speak sensitively

- Speak edifyingly

The lips of the righteous feed

many... (Proverbs 10: 21a HCSB)

Key 3: Speak sensitively

- **Speak softly**

A gentle answer turns away anger, but a harsh word stirs up wrath. (Proverbs 15: 1 HCSB)

Key 3: Speak sensitively

- **Speak tactfully**

...pleasant speech increases learning... Pleasant words are as a honeycomb: sweet to the taste and health to the body.

(Proverbs 16: 21b , 24 HCSB)

Key 3: Speak sensitively

- **Speak therapeutically**

The tongue that heals is a tree of life, but a devious tongue breaks the spirit. (Proverbs 15:

4 HCSB)

Key 3: Speak sensitively

- Speak truthfully

A lying tongue hates those it crushes, and a flattering mouth causes ruin. (Proverbs 26: 28

HCSB)

Key 3: Speak sensitively

- **Speak conscientiously**

Whoever conceals an offense promotes love, but whoever gossips about it separates

friends. (Proverbs 17: 9 HCSB)

Key 3: Speak sensitively

- **Speak peacefully**

As charcoal for embers and wood for fire, so is a quarrelsome man for kindling strife. (Proverbs 26:21 HCSB)
