





<p>Section A: GENERAL QUESTIONS</p>		
<p>1</p>	<p>Have you ever claimed to be a U.S. citizen?</p> <p><i>Don't lie. Don't make a false claim. Don't cross your fingers behind your back!</i></p> 	<p>No, I have never claimed to be a U.S. citizen.</p> <p><i>Always tell the truth about your Immigration status.</i></p> 

<p>VOTE</p>		
<p>2</p>	<p>Have you ever voted in any federal, state, or local election in the United States?</p>	<p>No, I have never voted in any federal, state, or local election in the United States.</p>
<p>3</p>	<p>What does “vote” mean?</p> 	<p>“Vote” means to choose a leader or law.</p> 
<p>4</p>	<p>If you become a U.S. citizen, will you vote?</p> 	<p>Yes, if I become a U.S. citizen, I will vote.</p>

<p>TAXES</p>		
<p>5</p>	<p>Do you pay your taxes every year?</p>	<p>Yes, I pay my taxes every year.</p>
<p>6</p>	<p>Do you owe any taxes?</p>	<p>No, I do not owe any taxes.</p> 
<p>7</p>	<p>What does “owe” mean?</p> 	<p>“Owe” means that I must pay money.</p>

<p>LEGALLY INCOMPETENT</p>		
<p>8</p>	<p>Have you ever been declared legally incompetent?</p> 	<p>No, I have not been declared legally incompetent.</p>
<p>9</p>	<p>What does “legally incompetent” mean?</p>	<p>“Legally incompetent” means that a judge says that I cannot make important life decisions. A lawyer, doctor, or family member must make decisions for me.</p>
